2020-21 XLP (www.xlp.org.uk) for a sports project in Newham and Tower Hamlets working with 100 young people at risk of educational failure, involvement in youth violence and knife crime).

2019-20 The AHOY Centre, a watersports charity in Deptford, for the purchase of an additional sailing boat. This will enable the charity to increase opportunities for disadvantaged and at-risk young people to take part in activities on the water that aim to promote transferable life skills.

2018-19 The Thrive Youth Trust's THRIVE in Design pilot project: collaborating with the recruitment industry to get young people facing unemployment and poverty into the design industry.

2017-18 The Suited & Booted Centre Ltd, for a new project, 'Young Suited & Booted', extending their Interview clothing and training for vulnerable adults to those under 25.

2016-17 The South London Refugee Association, supporting young, unaccompanied asylum seekers and refugees between the ages of 18 and 24.

2015-16 The Migrant and Immigrant Children's Legal Unit which provides legal and policy guidance to professionals involved with trafficked, migrant, refugee, and sometimes abused, children - including British children wrongly designated as migrants.

2014-15 Access All Areas 'Departure Lounge'
Access All Areas is a London-based theatre education group for adults with learning difficulties, which has an impressive record in helping adults with learning difficulties develop communication skills and employment opportunities. Our Award is funding a new programme of entry-level 'Departure Lounges', which started in the autumn. Participants have the opportunity to progress to performance work and a Diploma course recently launched by Access All Areas with the Central School of Speech and Drama.
